

Compost as Horse Bedding

Have you considered using recycled organics as horse bedding? Cressfield Farm trialled recycled organic material as bedding during the 2020 weaning season.

Q What is it made of?

A A blend of recycled organics (composted garden organics) and woodchips made fit-for-purpose by Australian Native Landscapes (ANL).

Q How did it perform?

- A The recycled organic material:
 - · Was easy to muck out;
 - Was odour-free with no traces of lingering ammonia;
 - Is not dusty the material maintains particle size and sufficient moisture to avoid becoming dusty;
 - Does not compact the variation in particle size helps retain structure;
 - Is highly absorbent without saturation; and
 - Does not bank up the yard walls.

Q Does it stain?

A None of the horses involved in the trial showed signs of staining from the material.

Q Will it irritate horses?

A Horses showed no signs of irritation.

Q Is it easy to work with?

A YES! Liesl Baumann, Cressfield Farm Operations Manager, said "We were really pleasantly surprised, and quite happy to have it in our yards".

Q Does it look different to sawdust?

A The material trialled at Cressfield Farm was slightly darker than traditional sawdust. This might take a little getting used to, but did not change how well it performed.
